

What are the benefits?

When you enroll in adultBasic, you can take advantage of the following benefits:

- Hospitalization (unlimited days);
- Physician Services (primary care and specialists);
- Emergency Services;
- Diagnostic Tests (e.g. X-rays, mammograms and laboratory tests);
- Maternity Care; and
- Rehabilitation and Skilled Care (in lieu of extended hospitalization).

There are certain out-of-pocket expenses for the program that you are responsible for, including:

- \$32 per month premium payment;
- \$5 copayment for each doctor visit;
- \$10 copayment for each specialist visit; and
- \$25 copayment for each emergency room visit (waived if admission to a hospital occurs).

adultBasic is Pennsylvania's newest health insurance program specifically for low-income adults, between 19 and 64, who have no health insurance coverage.

adultBasic is funded by a portion of the state's share of the tobacco settlement. The program began in July 2002. It provides health insurance for those who have jobs but no health insurance or who are between jobs.

The program offers basic benefits, including preventive care, physician services, diagnosis and treatment of illness or injury, in-patient hospitalization, out-patient hospital services and emergency accident and medical care. You only have to pay a \$30 monthly premium with modest copayments for certain benefits.

Income Guidelines

The following chart explains the number of people in the family versus the maximum income in order to be eligible for the program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS	
NUMBER IN FAMILY	MAXIMUM INCOME
1	\$19,140
2	\$25,660
3	\$32,180
4	\$38,700
5	\$45,220
6	\$51,740

For each additional person living in the household, add \$6,520.

How to Enroll

More information about Pennsylvania's adult health insurance program called **adultBasic** can be obtained by calling **1-800-GO-BASIC**. Applications also may be submitted via the Internet at **www.compass.state.pa.us**.

To be eligible for adultBasic, one must:

- Be a U.S. citizen between 19 and 64;
- Maintain residence in Pennsylvania for at least 90 days before applying;
- Have no coverage under any other insurance plan for at least 90 days before enrolling, except if you or your spouse lost health insurance coverage because you are no longer employed;
- Not be eligible for Medical Assistance or Medicare; and
- Meet income requirements.

Great news!

Unlike some other health insurance coverage, you can still get **adultBasic** even if you have a history of health problems.
